Changes in EU legislation?

- > The EU has set ambitious targets to reduce the use and risk of chemical pesticides by 50% in 2030, under the Farm to Fork and Biodiversity strategies.
- > Integrated Pest Management (IPM) and sustainable practices are increasingly required, with stricter monitoring and reporting obligations.
- > This legislation is not limited to the feed and food industry but will also include horticulture.
- > In short: less pesticide use, stricter residue control and more transparency.

This vision is supported by the **"Implementation Program Future Vision Crop Protection 2030"**, which contains steps and measures to achieve these goals. This program is in line with existing legislation and regulations, such as the **"European Water Framework Directive"**, and is regularly evaluated and adjusted based on new insights and developments.
